

NOTES:

The existing 18th hole presents a health and safety issue where stray golf balls are leaving the golf course on both the tee shots, second shots and shots into the green on the right slice side.

This has prompted flipping the golf holes and creating 60m from the centre line of play to the boundary on the left side. Mitigation planting, strategic bunker placement and mounding will also be incorporated to push play into the course.

There will be improved access created via the underpass from the 1st green to the 2nd tees and from the 17th green to the 18th tees. This limits the requirement for golfers to go up and over.

PROPOSED IMPROVED ACCESS VIA THE UNDERPASS BETWEEN HOLES 1 & 2 AND 17 & 18

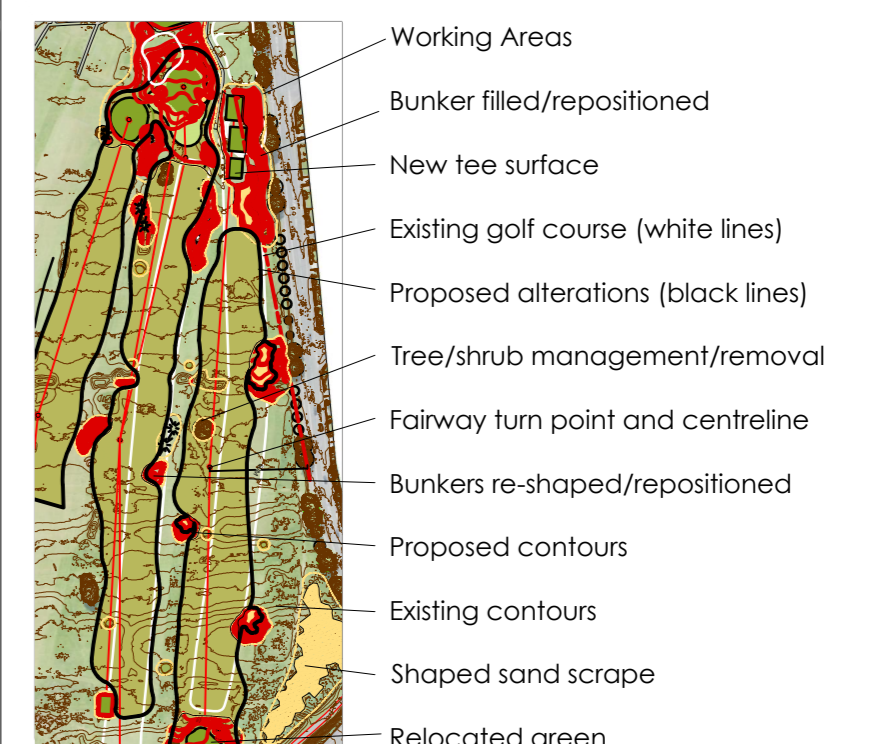
