NOTES:

An improved 4th hole will be created. The walk to the 5th tee will be 140m along the wide existing grass path which is 100m less than the current walk between the 2nd green and the 3rd tees.

In essence two improved holes will be created at the 3rd and 4th.

Generally more tees will be provided throughout the golf course to enhance playability for all categories of golfer.

Turf that is cut from the working areas may be re used to stabilise some of the existing sandy areas. We intend to contain sand in natural bunkers and stabilise and renovate the edges of these features to minimise sand blow and wind erosion, i.e. The 7th and 11th.

Irrigation is proposed throughout the course to help improve surfaces (water restrictions may apply).

Improved access will be created as well as visibility by extensive removal of scrub and bushes.

The 13th tees have been pulled back to create an improved landing area from the tee shot with the centre line of play being more than 60M from the boundary. Pulling the green shorter will reduce players forcing their second shots. This will also improve the 14th tee shot visual aspect.

The 15th tee shot will be pulled back to limit long balls reaching the low blind dip.
